

Marine Corps Marathon presents Race Director Boot Camp

Road race officials and event staff are invited to register for the Marine Corps Marathon Race Director Boot Camp, two days of intense Marine Corps-style event management training.

Presented by Runners World, the conference will take place on October 25 at the Hyatt Regency Washington on Capitol Hill, the Race Headquarters Hotel. Recruits will be briefed in a massive arsenal of topics by field specialists on Going Green, Race Marketing and Sponsorship, and Event Leadership. Feature sessions include Medical Operations, with guest speaker triathlete and Navy Lieutenant Andy Baldwin, MD, best known from ABC's "The Bachelor" and Risk Assessment,

an interactive experience designed by the Marine Corps War Fighting Lab.

Dinner is in the mess hall at the MCM Carbo Dining In. On race day, recruits can observe all tasks to accomplish mission at hand as they witness the Marine Corps Marathon with a VIP pass. Or they can choose PT (physical training) by falling in with MCM or MCM10K runners at the start line.
