## INTRODUCING THE CROSSROADS 17.75K



The new Crossroads 17.75K race will be held on June 12, 2010 in Prince William County. The unique distance commemorates the year the Marine Corps was founded and equates to 11.03 miles. The course begins on VA Highway 234 before heading into scenic Prince William National Forest Park. The Crossroads 17.75K culminates at the

National Museum of the Marine Corps, just outside the main gate of Marine Corps Base Quantico, known as the "Crossroads of the Corps." All runners and spectators can enjoy early admittance to the museum following the race. Runners and their families are encouraged to visit Prince William County, known as the "Outdoors Capital of the Capital Region," before and after the event to experience historic attractions, fine restaurants, distinctive shopping and pristine natural settings. ### MCM CELEBRATES 400,000TH FINISHER

Judith Mosely, 42, of Triangle, Virginia was the 18,530th finisher in the 2009 Marine Corps Marathon earning her recognition as the 400,000th finisher in the event's history. The mother of three completed her first marathon in 5:39:49 on her wedding anniversary. The MCM reached 100,000 finishers in 1990; 200,000 in 1998; and 300,000 in 2004. Work begins on reaching 500,000 finishers when registration for the 35th MCM on October 31, 2010 opens on April 7.
