Team Entry Instructions

1. Individual applications must be registered before the team application can be processed.
2. AN INDIVIDUAL CANNOT BE ON MORE THAN ONE TEAM.
3. All team members must be listed on the team application.
4. Teams will consist of at least three but no more than five runners.
5. In all cases, only the first three finishers will count for scoring except for the mixed (F) category. Finish place is computer by the average team time (aggregate time of top three finishers in each team).
6. The team captain must stop at Information during Packet Pick-up to verify team information and make changes. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
7. The team captain shall indicate the desired team category on the application. The Marine Corps Marathon headquarters will determine eligibility based on the individual team member's applications. Team category eligibility criteria are based on team representation and/or employment.
8. Team awards and all individual awards will be presented to the top THREE teams in each of the divisions.

Team Categories and Eligibility Criteria*

- A. Men: Any group of men.
- B. Women: Any group of women.
- C. Masters: Any group of men or women with each member at least 40 years old.
- D. Organization: Any group of people who are members of a corporation, local, state or federal government agency, or members of a formal club organized to promote running and physical fitness.
- E. Military: Any group of people who are members of the armed forces or are employed by the federal government and work for an armed force.
- F. Mixed: Any group of runners, but for scoring purposes, a male and female finishing time has to be used. The third finishing time can be of either sex.
