

2022 Marine Corps Historic Half Weekend to Run Live

Registration is now open for all three events

QUANTICO, VA (December 1, 2021) – The Marine Corps Historic Half Weekend will return live and in-person to Fredericksburg, VA on May 20 – 22, 2022. Runners can celebrate by registering now for the Marine Corps Historic Half (MCHH), Semper 5ive or Devil Dog Double at www.marinemarathon.com.

“We couldn’t ask for a better way to celebrate the 15th anniversary of the Historic Half than bringing the live event back to Fredericksburg,” said Rick Nealis, director at Marine Corps Marathon Organization. “Our team is working with the community to make this year’s event bigger and better, including implementing more of the town’s history and finishing at the FredNats Ballpark.”

Registration costs and qualifications for each event are as follows:

The 15th Marine Corps Historic Half:

- Ages 10 and up
- Cost is \$75
- 17:30 minute mile pace required

Devil Dog Double:

- Ages 14 and up
- Cost is \$95
- 12:00 minute mile pace required

Semper 5ive:

- Ages 7 and up
- Cost is \$45
- 20:00 minute mile pace required

Participants receive a short sleeve technical shirt, a spinning finisher medal and more.

The Semper Fidelis Challenge will be back in 2022. Runners interested in taking on the challenge will simply register for either the MCHH or the Devil Dog Double, plus in February register for the Marine Corps Marathon (MCM) or MCM50K. Previous deferments are able to be utilized. Only those running in the live and in-person events will be eligible for the special Semper Fidelis Challenge medal. The MCMO will track which runners qualify in-house.

The MCHH events are also part of the Distinguished Participant program. Dedicated participants can #RunWithTheMarines for the following live events:

- Marine Corps Historic Half events (Marine Corps Historic Half, Semper 5ive or Devil Dog Double)
- Belleau Wood 8K or Crossroads Trail 15K
- Quantico 12K
- Turkey Trot 10K

Completion of all four tiers will qualify runners for the exclusive 2022 Distinguished Participant medal.

This year will mark the first time in two years that the MCHH and Devil Dog Double will be held in-person as both ran virtually in 2020 and 2021 due to COVID-19 health concerns. After running virtually in 2020, the Semper 5ive ran in 2021 aboard Marine Corps Base Quantico.
