

## Free Shuttles Available for Runners, Spectators at Historic Half

### *Road Closures to occur May 21 in Fredericksburg, VA*

QUANTICO, VA (May 8, 2017) – The Marine Corps Historic Half and the City of Fredericksburg, VA will welcome thousands of participants and spectators to [Marine Corps Historic Half Weekend](#) from May 19 to 21.

Roads will close only on Marine Corps Historic Half Sunday, May 21, starting at 6:30 a.m. A [rolling road opening](#) will continue throughout the event as the last runners travel the 13.1-mile course.

However, roads will close starting at 5:30 a.m. near the Marine Corps Historic Half start and finish on Carl D. Silver Parkway from Fall Hill Avenue to the Expo Center. Also starting at 5:30 a.m., Fall Hill Avenue will be closed from Pelham Street to Canal Street, to include both Maury and Green Streets, for the start of the new [Devil Dog Double](#) and the [Semper 5ive](#) presented by Navy Federal Credit Union.

Free [shuttle services](#) will be offered from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Saturday, May 20, for attendees of the [Healthy Lifestyle Expo](#) with round-trip transportation to [historic downtown Fredericksburg](#). Trolley Tours of Fredericksburg will transport Expo attendees to the many shops, restaurants, galleries, museums and significant landmarks in historic downtown.

On Sunday, May 21, continuous free [shuttle services](#) will be available post event for the Semper 5ive (five miler) and Devil Dog Double finishers. Semper 5ive/Devil Dog Double participants will find [ample parking](#) near the start of their event located at the intersection of Fall Hill Avenue and Germania Street.

After enjoying post-race hospitality, Semper 5ive and Devil Dog Double runners can board free shuttle buses from the Central Park Walmart to return to their vehicles. Post-event shuttle services will operate from 7:45 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Historic Half marathon participants will park in lots located at Fredericksburg's Central Park, near the Historic Half start and finish.

[Spectators](#) can embark event-day shuttles to a downtown Fredericksburg viewing location. Shuttles will operate from 7:45 to 10:15 a.m. transporting spectators from Walmart to Hurkamp Park, near Mile 7.5 of the 13.1-mile Historic Half course.
