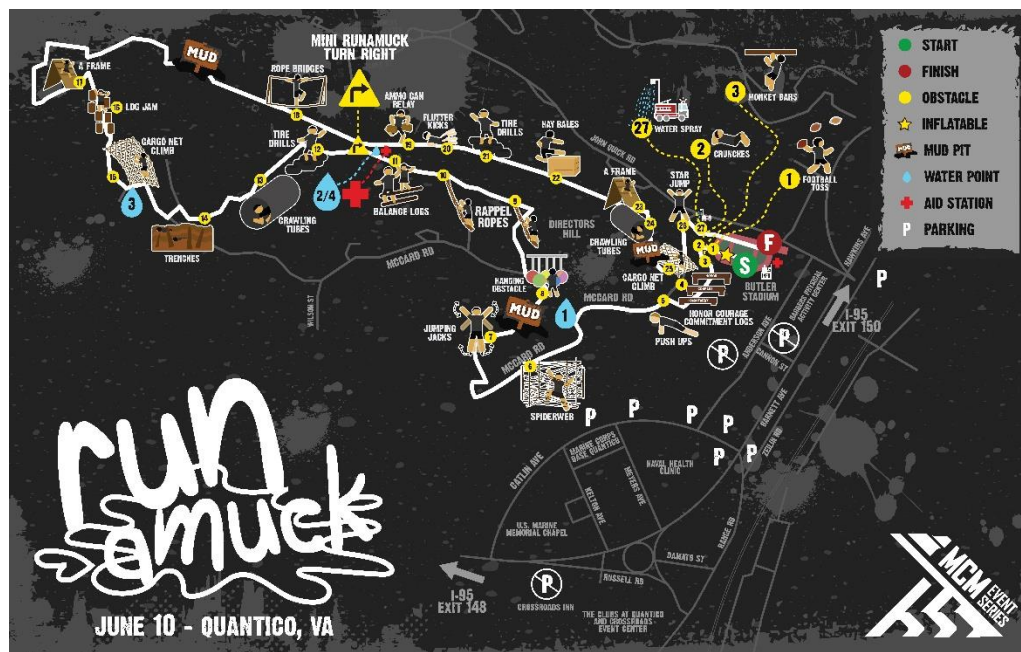
‘Little Dirt, Can’t Hurt’ at Run Amuck on June 10 at Quantico

Registration is open for four and two-mile mud and obstacle run with the Marines

QUANTICO, VA (May 23, 2017) – Tell Mom a “little dirt, can’t hurt” and register for Run Amuck presented by Camelbak® Saturday, June 10. Participants will face more than 25 obstacles and military PT drills while tackling a four-mile run through giant mud pits, and over the hills and trails of Marine Corps Base Quantico.

Register for the four mile Run Amuck or two-mile Mini at www.marinemarathon.com. Run Amuck is \$45, Mini costs \$30 to register with participants receiving a technical Run Amuck T-shirt, commemorative bib and face towel.

New to Run Amuck’s adventurous course is the Rainforest, complete with sounds of the tropical forest.



Runners will be challenged by obstacles like rappel ropes, the A-frame climb, crawling tubes, cargo net, rope bridge, trenches, tire drills, spider web and log jam. The three large mud pits are deep and wide leaving runners covered in muck.

Waves of runners will depart from the start line at 7 a.m. and be launched every 20 minutes, through 9:20 a.m. The start and finish for both events will be located at Quantico’s historic Butler

Stadium, located behind the installation’s Barber Gym.

Mud run participants can obtain refreshing relief with misters set along the course and from the giant water blast, courtesy of the Quantico Fire Department. In addition, participants can “get their game faces on” at the complimentary camouflage paint and tattoo stations, located near the Run Amuck start.

Runners will also enjoy popsicles, courtesy of Wegmans, in post-event hospitality and the Michelob ULTRA® Beer garden. Plenty of event-day parking is available.
